CABIN SITE

The log sill is chosen as appropriate to mark the outline of the cabins; the hearth and fireplace are chosen because they have been the altar of the home, the center around which Lincoln, at his mother's knee, learned of integrity and strength. The entire conception is cast in bronze in order that it may be durable and that it may not in any way seem a reconstruction of the original cabins.
