as set forth in the record of his case, as follows:

in Marblehead Massachusetts. Admitted Navy 9th
1865 with Petris. Typhoides Died Janu 31st 1865
The disease had its origin in exposure while on duty
in the Naval Brigade on the expedition to Pocataligo
Bridge and therefore in the line of duty
