Dear Sir,

I supposed I had made an arrangement with Judge Read by which we were both to remain at home this summer. I was induced to make the proposition from the consideration, that both public and private duties required it. I am aware of the State House and it is my place to examine the materials as they are daily brought to the ground. I have however rec'd a letter from the Judge in answer to mine accepting his modification to my proposition to remain at home, in which he had reserved the right to go to the counties he did not reach before, giving me the same right, and by his last letter I am told that not receiving mine as soon as he expected he had sent out notices.

Will you be kind enough to write and let me know whether I had better visit Saratoga or not? and tell me what the Judge did when with you. So far I am content and gratified with the news from the out counties. Have you got your pistols for the company you command?
